CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

The UWM Foundation, through its Alumni Activities Committee, has created an opportunity for the university and greater community to learn directly from distinguished alumni who have demonstrated a high level of leadership and accomplishment in their professional field. This objective will be reached through the new UWM Foundation Alumni Fellows Program, which will recognize and provide a teaching forum for select members of the university's most distinguished alumni.

Annually, the UWM Foundation Alumni Activities Committee will invite members of the university community to submit nominations for the designation of UWM Alumni Fellow. The committee anticipates that the nominees will be among the most illustrious individuals to have earned degrees from UWM. A selection committee will name one or two persons each year as UWM Alumni Fellows.

Each Alumni Fellow will return to campus to spend a day or more with students, faculty, staff, and additional members of the campus community to share insights and experiences from the decades since he or she attended UWM. These interactions may be in the form of classroom participation, informal discussions, lectures or presentations. As appropriate, a community forum will also offer the opportunity for members of the greater community to interact with and learn from the Alumni Fellow. The responsibility for organizing and scheduling these activities will rest with the Office of Development in conjunction with the school/college/unit nominating the Alumni Fellow.
